***NEW* Cookery Club**

A club run by Smart Raspberry Cookery School where your child will make a variety of savoury and sweet dishes. All ingredients, cooking equipment and packaging are provided in the cost of the sessions, and your child will take home what they've made at the end of each session. Your child will also be given laminated recipe cards with a healthy message on the back. The dishes they make will be either ready to eat or need to be baked or refrigerated at home.



Children will learn to:

- Prepare a variety of sweet and savoury dishes
- Measure, weigh and follow recipes (using maths and reading skills in real life!)
- Understand the importance of hygiene and food safety
- Try new ingredients and flavours
- Build confidence and independence in the kitchen

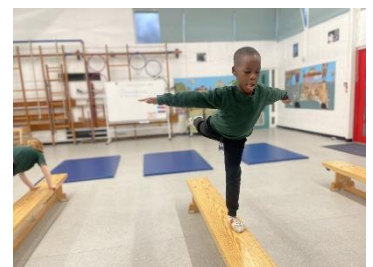
***NEW* Dance Club**

A club run by Divas and Dudes Dance Academy where your child will have fun learning routines and performing whilst develop their sense of rhythm, coordination & movement and, most importantly, their confidence.



***NEW* Gymnastics Club**

A club run by CMC Gymnastics where your child will learn how to perform basic and advanced gymnastics movements and routines under the guidance of a nationally recognised gymnastics coach. They will be active and have fun with their friends as their build on their gymnast skills – no gymnastic experience is required.



***NEW* Board Games Club**

A club run by Mrs. Plunkett where your child will learn to play a variety of fun board games. Through playing together, your child will develop important social skills such as turn-taking, teamwork, communication, and good sportsmanship. They will also learn how to cope positively with both winning and losing while building friendships and having fun.



***NEW* Sugar Craft Club**

A club run by Daisy Cakes where your child will learn to make cake toppings from scratch by manipulating different coloured sugar paste. They will learn techniques for how to make themed creations, and your child will be able to take a new creation home every session.

Note: The sugar paste used in the club may contain nuts.
