

Maths – This term we will be learning about:

Numbers to 20 and beyond
Manipulate, compose
and decompose

In this topic we will learn about different places around the world and which transport we would need to use to get to them. We will look at local areas familiar to the children, where children can talk about their experiences and view these on aerial maps. Children will have opportunity to explore similarities and differences between transport used in the past and now. Children will write letters to a school in a different country and will walk to the box post to post them, whilst out they will carry out a traffic survey of our local area.
