

School Performance Data

At St Cecilia's CE Primary School all members of staff are committed to ensuring that every single child makes the best progress they can and as a team, we work hard to optimise progress for all children. There is a robust assessment system in place and Pupil Progress meetings are held regularly where the Leadership team meets with the class teachers and we discuss the progress of the children. We review their progress and set challenging targets. We also identify strategies to facilitate further support that may be needed to enable each child to meet his/her targets. These strategies will include a range of approaches - booster/individual support, extension/enrichment sessions and learning interventions.

Primary School Progress Measures

In 2016 the DfE introduced new end of Y6 tests which assess the new curriculum launched in 2014. The results are now published as scaled scores rather than levels. These scaled scores are used to calculate the progress measures of a Primary School.
